Academic WorldQuest is a Flagship Program of the World Affairs Council System. WorldQuest is a team game testing high school competitors' knowledge of international affairs, geography, history and culture. The local metropolitan Washington winning team competes in the World Affairs Council of America's national competition being held on April 5, 2008, in Washington DC.

The game is a contest between 4-person teams. It is moderated by a prominent person in the field of international affairs or journalism. Teams compete by answering rounds of questions projected by PowerPoint onto a screen. A full competition is 100 questions, 10 rounds of 10 questions per round. The winning team is the team with the highest number of right answers.

This event is free for all teams, and all high schools in the D.C.-metropolitan area are eligible to participate.
